Health & Safety Policy

Cambridge University Cricket Club is strongly committed to the health, well-being and safety of all its Members, Volunteers, visitors and officials.

This Policy should be read in conjunction with the ***Code of Conduct***.

CUCC duties

- Ensure recorded risk assessments of Club premises are undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Club
- Creating a safe environment by putting health and safety measures in place as identified by risk assessment.
 - Ensuring that normal operating procedures and emergency operating procedures are in place for and that suitable information is made available to Members.
 - Ensuring access to adequate First Aid facilities and qualified first aider.
- Ensuring that all playing members are given the appropriate level of training and competition by regularly assessing individual ability dependant on age, maturity and development.
- Making Members are aware of the requirement to comply with this health and safety policy.
- Appointing a competent Club Member to assist with health and safety responsibilities.
- Reporting any injuries or accidents sustained during any Club activity or whilst on the club premises.
- Monitoring and reviewing effectiveness of implementation of this policy regularly.

Club Members' and Volunteers Duties

- Comply with the ***Code of Conduct*** and take reasonable care for your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or not do.
- Wear the appropriate protective equipment during practice and matches and behave responsibly towards other players, officials and spectators.
- Co-operate with the club on health and safety issues.
- Correctly use all equipment and facilities provided by the club.
- Check Health & Safety arrangements on arrival at way matches.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.
